March 15, 2012: Train to Dallas Blooms

We will ride the Heartland Flyer from Norman to Gainesville, Texas. A Red Carpet bus will take us to Rumpy's Little German Bakery for lunch. The Dallas Arboretum tour will include the gardens & DeGolyer Estate which is located along White Lake. The 21,000 square foot mansion will be the setting for the Tea which is included in the trip. Cost: \$133 which includes the motor coach, train, Arboretum tour, Tea, tips and guide Joan Greenwood.

March 29-30, 2012: Azalea Festival & Canton "First Monday". This trip will include a tour of the town with azaleas, beautiful homes and stunning yards. We will attend the "Apache Belles" spring show in the evening, a dinner buffet at Sweet Susie's which is included in the price of the trip. We will visit many vendors showing jewelry, purses, shoes, dishes, antiques, clothing, junk and just about anything that you may or may not need. April 12, 2012: Chishom Trail Heritage Center & Show at Simmons Center. This trip will include the Heritage Center, dinner in Duncan, the Simmons Center show "Dragon's Tale". This show includes colorful costumes, swirling banners, acrobats and modern dance based on traditional Chinese folk dances. Cost: \$85. Payment due March 13th.

April 19, 2012: Chickasaw Cultural Center

The center has become one of Oklahoma's prime tourist attractions, drawing visitors from many states & other countries. The history and culture of the Chickasaw Nation is beautifully presented. Cost: \$39 (credit card) or \$37 (discount by check).

CAKE RECIPE FOR ONE: 3, 2, 1, CAKE:

INGREDIENTS:

1 box Angel Food Cake Mix

1 box Cake Mix - Any Flavor

Makes 1 serving.

DIRECTIONS:

In a zip-loc bag, combine the two cake mixes together and mix well. For each individual cake serving, take out **3** Tablespoons of the cake mix combination and mix it with **2** Tablespoons of water in a small microwave-safe container. Microwave on high for **1** minute, and you have your own instant individual little cake! ONE OF THE CAKE MIXES MUST BE ANGEL FOOD.

You can top the cake with frosting, cool whip, fruit, or any of your favorite toppings.
